5. Planning Matters

- 5.1 HHP/2026/115 / LBC 2026/18 Ty Rallt, Pont Rhydbont
Listed Building Consent for refurbishments and improvements to an existing two-storey Grade II listed building and adjacent single storey stable together with extension to the existing rear single storey kitchen – no objections.
- 5.2 LUE 2026/13 To Gwyrdd, Pont-Rhyd-Y-Bont
Application for a Certificate of Lawfulness to confirm that a material operation was lawfully undertaken in accordance with planning permission reference 43C32F/DEL on land adjacent land. – no objections.
- 5.3 FPL/2025/287 - Refail Farm Estate, Pontrhydybont - complaint that work had been carried out on the site despite the planning application being refused. - Planning Enforcement Officers had been alerted.
