- 1. **Apologies:** Councillors Mike Bloor, Iwan Jones and Tony Thompson
- 2. **Declaration of Interest:** – none
- 3. **Minutes of previous meeting:** the minutes of the 10 August 2023 were accepted as correct (prop. Cllrs. S. Hanbury, seconded W. Roberts).
- 4. **Matters arising from the minutes**

- 4.1 The Community Council had been advised that Cyngor Cymuned Rhoscolyn could be used on all Welsh documentation in future.
- 4.2 Parking issues Pontrhydybont – on going
- 4.3 Errors on the new visitor's sign in Trearddur Bay – Further enquiries established that the sign with the white arch/black arch errors etc. was created as part of the Holy Island International Visitor Gateway Project run by IOACC. It was agreed to forward the correct information to the project officer with a request that it be rectified.
There followed a discussion about the importance of maintaining traditional place names and the possibility of reinstating some of these on local signs etc.

5. Planning

- 5.1 FPL/2023/6 Hafod y Plas, Pontrhydybont
Outline application for the erection of a rural enterprise dwelling with some matters reserved – no objection.
- 5.2 FPL/2023/243 Rhyd y Bont, Pontrhydybont
Full application for the conversion of an existing farm outbuilding into an annex ancillary to the existing dwelling together with extension to the existing residential curtilage, installation of a package treatment plant and soak-away – The Council objected to this application, it was not demonstrated that there was an overriding need for an annex to the main dwelling – the proposal was a separate self-contained unit and should be treated as such. It was also noted that the plans for this application was almost identical to application FPL/2023/32 (5.3 below) which had shown this as a plan for separate holiday accommodation.
- 5.3 FPL/2023/32 Rhyd y Bont, Pontrhydybont - withdrawn
- 5.4 LUP/2023/5 Cil y Gwynt, Rhoscolyn – granted.

- 6.1 Ash Dieback Works – the County Councils' contractors were already cutting down diseased trees along the highways and public places where necessary.
- 6.2 Anglesey County Council Statement on RAAC concrete - Holyhead Secondary School was the most affected and was only partly open. IOACC was awaiting the outcome of a specialist examination and were looking at a number of options to ensure pupils were not missing out on their education.
