2. **Declaration of Interest:** – none
3. **Minutes of previous meeting:** the minutes of the 29 June 2023 were accepted as correct (prop. S. Hanbury, seconded T. Thompson).
4. **Matters arising from the minutes**
 - 4.1 The clerk would arrange a meeting with the County Council to discuss the parking issues in Pontrhydybont.
5. **Planning**
 - 5.1 **HHP/2023/160 Ty Rhos, Pontrhydybont**
Full application for the erection of a workshop – no objection.
 - 5.2 **LUP/2023/5 Cil y Gwynt, Rhoscolyn**
Application for a Certificate of Lawfulness for the proposed use of land for the erection of a dwelling which was granted under planning application reference V/205 and safeguarded by Certificate of Lawfulness application reference 43C134B/LUC on land – Members were concerned about the prospect of further developments in that vicinity. Access to the site is via an extremely narrow lane that is particularly busy in the summer months and waste water drainage had become an issue due to the very large scale development of several neighbouring properties.
