3. **Balchder yn Eich Cymuned**

Roedd Cyng. S. Hanbury a'r clerch wedi cyfarfod gyda Pheiriannydd Grŵp – Rheolwr Gwaith Stryd a Gorfodaeth Parcio Cyngor Sir Ynys Môn ac wedi cael cadarnhad y byddai creu lle eistedd a gardd gymunedol wrth ochr y lloches fws ar y sgwar ym Mhontrhydybont yn dderbyniol. Roedd o hefyd yn fodlon i'r Cyngor osod diffibriliwr ar wal gardd gyferbyn a'r lle glas o flaen Maes Llety.

Cytunwyd i brynnu pedair mainc a thri planter hir gan Earth Anchors Ltd am £3053 a phlanhigion a choed i roi yno. Amcan bris am goed planhigion, compost a thirlunio - £1800

Cytunwyd hefyd i brynnu difibrilwr am £1600 (heb ei osod) i roi ar wal rhif 2 Ffordd Caradog ac o bosib un arall os oedd lle addas yw rhoi.

Yn y cyfamser hefyd cafwyd cais am loches fws wrth Westy'r Anchorage. Cytunwyd y byddai'r clerch yn gwneud ymchwil brys i'r posibilrwydd o wneud hyn.

Y bwriad oedd gwneud yn fawr o'r grant a gynnigwyd er y bydd angen swm rhesymol o arian ychwanegol i ariannu popeth.

4. **Cyfrifon Terfynol 2025/26**

Dosbarthwyd copi o'r Ffurflen Flynyddol ac adroddiad yr Archwilydd Mewnol i'r Aelodau. Cafwyd cadarnhad gan yr Archwilydd Mewnol fod y cyfrifon mewn trefn ac nad oedd argymhellion ar gyfer sylw'r Cyngor. Cytunwyd yn unfrydol i dderbyn yr adroddiad.

5. **Cyfarfod nesaf 2 Gorffennaf 2026**

**Minutes of the Extra Ordinary Meeting of Rhoscolyn Community Council
which took place on Zoom at 7pm on Thursday 25 June 2026.**

3. **Pride in Your Community**

Cllr S. Hanbury and the clerk had met with the Isle of Anglesey County Council's Group Engineer – Street Works and Parking Enforcement Manager and received confirmation that the creation of seating and community garden alongside the bus shelter on the square in Pontrhydybont would be acceptable. He was also satisfied that the Council could install a defibrillator on a garden wall opposite the green space in front of Maes Llety.

It was agreed to purchase four benches and three long planters from Earth Anchors Ltd for £3053 and plants and trees to go there. Approximate price for plant trees, compost and landscaping - £1800

It was also agreed to buy a defibrillator for £1600 (excluding installation) to put opposite Maes Llety and possibly another if there was a suitable place to donate.

Meanwhile there was a request for bus shelter by the Anchorage Hotel. It was agreed that the clerk would make urgent research into the possibility of doing this.

The intention was to make the most of the grant offered although a reasonable amount of additional money would be needed to fund everything.

4. **Final Accounts 2025/26**

A copy of the Annual Form and the Internal Auditor's report were distributed to Members. The Internal Auditor confirmed that the accounts were in order and that there were no recommendations for the Council's attention. It was unanimously agreed to accept the report.

The Chair and the SCC will approve the Annual Form and send it with the requested documents to the External Auditor.
